Coverage:

Participants will be introduced to the fundamental concepts of linguistics (Bhaashaa Vigyaan) relevant to both languages, fostering a deeper understanding of their structure and evolution. The Programme will explore literary traditions, both classical and contemporary, and the interpretative frameworks of Indian philosophy. A key component includes exposure to the diverse dimensions of Indian knowledge systems, offering insights into indigenous intellectual traditions. Throughout the program, lectures will be organized on various aspects of language and literature, as well as life skills, linguistic approaches, and the evaluation of literature in the contemporary context. This FDP will promote Indian languages and the Indian knowledge tradition in the modern era.

Pedagogy:

- The FDP will employ a blended, interactive, and multi-modal approach, including expert talks, discussions, presentations, reflections and feedback at the end of each day
